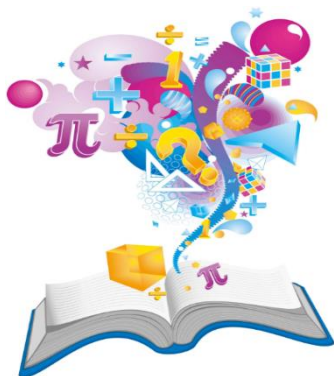


Mental Maths Challenges

Count in multiples of 6 and 7		
Find 1000 more or less of any given number E.g. what is 1000 more than 2324?		
Recognise the value of each digit in a 4 digit number (Thousands, Hundreds, Tens and Ones)		
Round any number to the nearest 10		
Add numbers mentally, including 4 digit number and ones ($1456+8$) and a 4 digit number and hundreds ($1456+200$)		
Recall and use multiplication facts for 6 times tables

Recall and use multiplication facts for 7 times tables		
Count up and down in hundredths		
Use addition skills to solve money problems ie £14.56 add 20p		
Tell and write the time from an analogue clock to the nearest minute		

Guidance for Parents

At Weyford Nursery and Primary School, we have noticed that if children know certain facts, it helps them become more confident at solving a variety of mathematical problems that they will encounter on their learning journey.

We would suggest that you start by going through this pack with your child and see what he/she already knows and what still needs to be learned. Remember to praise your child for facts already known.

Encourage your child to revisit this regularly and then when confident, it will be checked at school.

You could

- ask your child to test you, to see who is quicker
- Make it fun by making up worded questions.
